

Phu – Phoo – Fu stats from the 2011 National Population and Housing Census

Households: 36 with a total number of 176 inhabitants.

Of these 4 households totaling 9 people, are marked as absent.

So – 32 households and 167 inhabitants.

The **cast/ethnicity** is overwhelmingly Bhote – 172 of 176.

And yet, the census notes that Nepali is the **mother tongue** of 171 of the inhabitants.

House Construction: all 36 with foundations of mud bonded bricks and stone,
outer walls of mud bonded bricks and stone, and
all but one with mud roofs. 1 has a tile/ slate roof.

Drinking Water: 34 households have tap/piped water

Fuel used for cooking: all use wood

Source of Lighting: all but one use solar panels; 1 uses kerosene

Toilets: 31 households are without toilet facilities; 4 have a flush toilet; 1 has an ordinary toilet

Facilities: other than a radio none had any – i.e. computers, televisions, telephones,
