

The Ranger Station is no more but the fire tower at the top of Maple Mtn still stands.

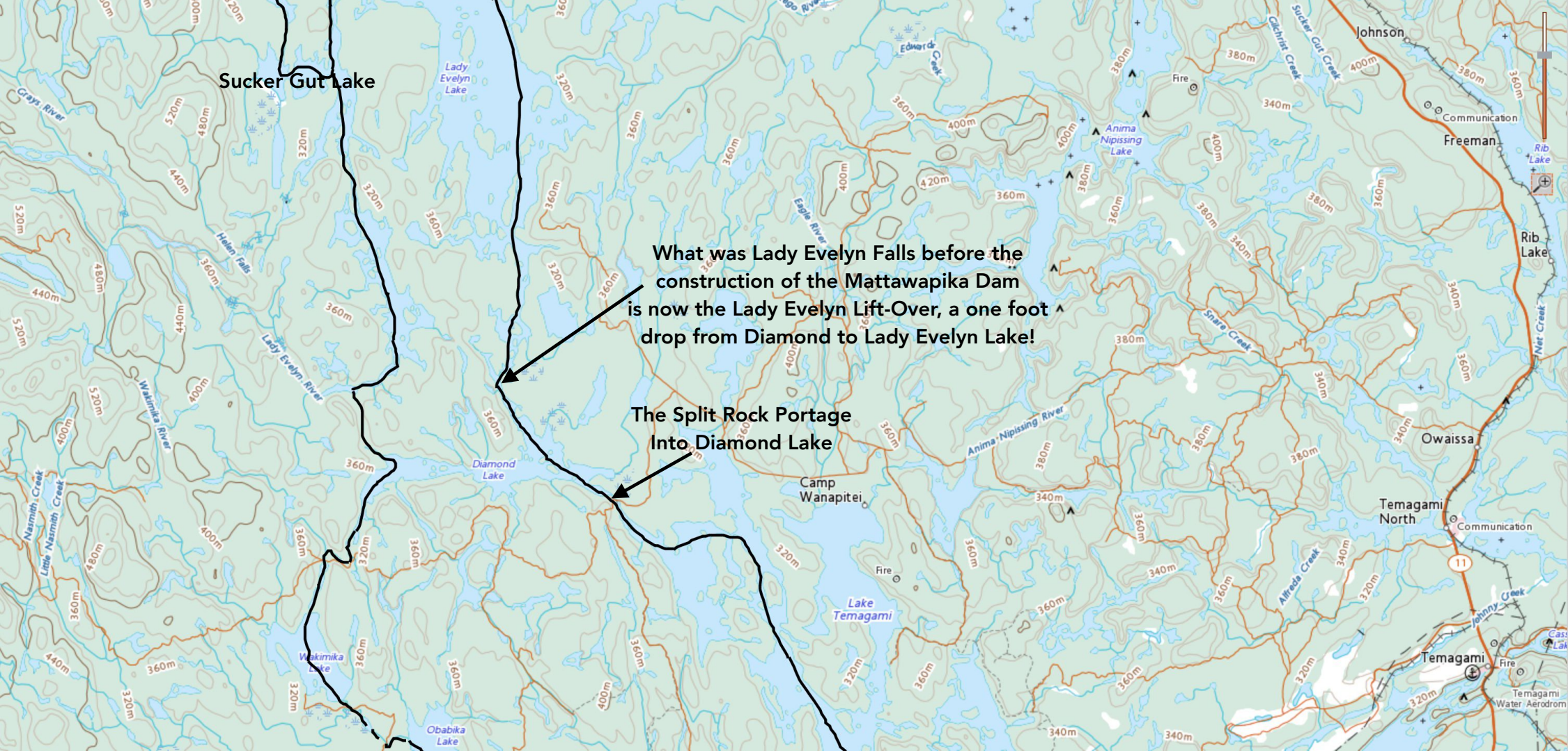
Mattawapika Dam →
